HAUPPAUGE SCHOOL'S WEBSITE IS A SOURCE OF VALUABLE INFORMATION

The Hauppauge School District website is a source of valuable information. We don't want our Hauppauge School Community ever to be left in the dark when it comes to receiving helpful and up-to-date information. Let's break it down to help you become better familiarized with our website!



First and foremost, our web address! It is www.hauppauge.k12.ny.us. Typing in this web address brings you to our District Home. Let's explore some of the different sections that contain the information you may be seeking at any time during the school year.

"Home Page" - The "Home Page" is the District Home which represents the school district as a whole. On this page, you will find various tabs which allow you to navigate. You can "Select a School" which will take you to the home page of the particular school you are seeking for more detailed information pertaining to that school.

Located in the white bar are icons for apps which connect to various websites. Some of these are the Parent Portal, Infinite Campus, Facebook and Twitter.

Below this white bar are "Navigation Tabs" which will take you to the following:

"About Us" - This tab contains information about the District, lists our schools (pictures are linked to each school), and contains directions and address information. There is also Registra-



tion infomation located under that tab.


"Board of Education" - This tab has many sections; from learning about our members of the Board of Education to finding Meeting Agendas, Meeting Minutes and Board Policies and Regulations, to name a few.

"Administration" - Under this tab you will find a listing of our District Administrators which allows you to click into a more detailed section highlighting each Administrator.

From here you can also navigate into each Department; view the Athletics site, find Forms, see what is available for Parents, view Employment Opportunities, view Community information, School Budget information and view videos which include the Board of Education meetings and more.

As you scroll down the home page, you will see a photo gallery which rotates with photos of our students. These are frequently updated, so you may see your child on here at some point! To the left, there is an "Announcements" section which contains our newest items for you to check out, such as our "Horizons" issues, 2018-2019 School Calendar, our Code of Conduct and our Board Policy Manual which contains all of our Board of Education policies.

To the right, you will see a listing of "<u>Upcoming Events</u>" which are updated daily according to the website's calendar, where these are also listed.







In the center, under "<u>Headlines and Happenings</u>" you will find our more recent headlines regarding upcoming events for our students, as well as articles on student achievements. Just below that, we have a Twitter feed with Tweets from Administrators and teachers which also provide valuable updates and information. Follow us on Twitter and Facebook! When you are navigating to a particular school, you will find that each school page is set up in the same way, however, each school has Announcements, Upcoming Events, Headlines and Happenings and a photo gallery which pertains to just that school. Each school has an "Administration" tab which highlights their Principal and Assistant Principals. There is also a teacher listing for each school. Each teacher maintains a page which may include information and assignments.

On the High School site, you will find the "Announcements" section filled with items for exam information and National Honor Society Extra Help Club, to name a few. On the right side, there is a section for "Resources and Links" which houses the High School Bell Schedule, bus information, Naviance, the Course Catalog, and many other resources.

On the Middle School site, you will find their "back to school" packet, supply lists and school calendars, as well as the bell schedule and listing of clubs.

On the Bretton Woods, Forest Brook and Pines Elementary School sites, you will find similar information which includes the Summer Reading Program, Jump Start Program, Summer Slide Challenge and Supply Lists for each grade. There is also a link to the lunch menu which gives an overview from Whitson's Culinary. They provide information through this link on menus, meal pricing, and topics on "Food Waste Reduction, Meatless Monday and the Healthy Hunger-Free Kids Act."
