All Science Fair projects are due in school on the morning of **Tuesday, March 19th between 7:30 & 10:30AM!**

Please bring your completed Project Display Boards to the gym.

You may enter from the back parking lot of the building and drop off through the rear, exterior gym doors before 9:00 AM; after 9:00 AM, please enter through the front doors and sign in.

Projects may NOT be dropped off early or kept in school prior to the Science Fair.

Please remember that names & photos of students are NOT permitted to appear on project display boards!

If you wish to bring in materials used for your project, please remember that space is very limited and although we try to keep all items safe, unfortunately accidents may occur. It is only the information presented on the display board that is being judged.

PARENTS/GUARDIANS, SIBLINGS, RELATIVES & FRIENDS ARE INVITED TO VISIT THE SCIENCE FAIR ON WEDNESDAY ~ MARCH 20TH FROM 6:30PM - 7:45PM.

It is recommended that all projects be taken home that evening.

We ask that you wait to remove any projects until 7:30 PM in order to give everyone the opportunity to view all projects.

Please remember to keep projects safe until all placements have been announced as the first place winner from each grade level will be invited to represent Pines at the Brookhaven National Lab Elementary School Science Fair on Saturday ~ May 6, 2019

Judging is set to take place on Tuesday, March 19th. Judges consist of science teachers from the Middle School and High School who volunteer their time, as well as exceptional high school seniors enrolled in a science research program. The judging criteria were supplied in the packet that was distributed in January. Awards will be given for 1st, 2nd & 3rd placements for all grades as well as two Honorable Mentions for grades 3-5. There will be an interview process for students in grades 3 - 5; five finalists from grades 3-5 will be selected and interviewed to determine the placements. Interviews are set to take place during the day on Wed., March 20th.

Classes will have the opportunity to visit the Science Fair during the school day on Tuesday & Wednesday.
