



School Delay and Early Release FAQ for Parents

Q: If there is a delayed opening what is the impact for my child who attends BOCES at the secondary level?

A: For Students in CTE half-day AM programs No School Transportation to/from BOCES will be provided. Students can choose to either:

- Come in to the HS when their classes begin, *or*
- If AM transportation is needed, students can remain in the Library until Period 6 begins.

For students in a full-day program, follow the delayed opening schedule and transportation will be provided to BOCES.

Q: If my child participates in any before school activities within the district will they be canceled?

A: Yes, **ALL** before school activities will be canceled.

Q: What if my child attends the UPK within the district at Bretton Woods, Pines and Forest Brook?

A: UPK within the district will follow the Hauppauge schedule and will also be delayed.

Q: Will the Half-Day SCOPE 3 year old program be impacted by the delayed opening?

A: The SCOPE 3 year old program will be canceled if the district is operating on a delayed opening schedule.

Q: Where do I find the delayed opening bus schedule?

A: Bus pick up times will be on a 2-Hour Delay from the original time.

ex. Regular time 6:40am = new time (on or around) 8:40 am

Q: If my child attends a private or parochial school what time will they get picked up if the the school they attend is not on a delayed bus schedule?

A: If the Hauppauge School District is on a delayed schedule, your child will need to follow the Hauppauge schedule and will be delayed accordingly.

Q: Will there be after-school sports and clubs if there is an early release?

A: No! All after-school activities K-12 will be canceled.
