



## School Delay and Early Release FAQ for Parents

**Q: If there is a delayed opening, what is the impact on my child who attends BOCES at the secondary level?**

A: For students in CTE half-day AM programs, school transportation to/from BOCES will **NOT** be provided.

Students can choose to either:

- Come into the HS when their classes begin, *or*
- If AM transportation is needed, students can remain in the Library until Period 6 begins.

For students in a full-day program, follow the delayed opening schedule and transportation will be provided to BOCES.

**Q: If my child participates in any before-school activities (including SCOPE before-care) within the district, will they be canceled?**

A: Yes, **ALL** before-school activities will be canceled.

**Q: What if my child attends the UPK program within the district at Bretton Woods, Pines or Forest Brook?**

**A: School Delay:** UPK within the district will follow the Hauppauge schedule and will also be delayed for the same amount of time as their home building.

**A: Early Release:** ALL UPK students will be released one hour earlier than the K-5 students in their home building. (For example, if Bretton Woods K-5 is dismissed at 2:30 pm UPK students will be dismissed at 1:30)

**Q: Where do I find the delayed opening bus schedule?**

A: Bus pickup times will be on a 2-hour Delay from the original time.

ex. Regular time 6:40 am = new time (on or around) 8:40 am

Please review the individual school start times:

Forest Brook: 8:30 am, Bretton Woods: 9:00 am, Pines: 9:00 am, MS: 8:00 am, HS: 7:30 am

**Q: If my child attends a private or parochial school, what time will they get picked up if the school they attend is not on a delayed bus schedule?**

A: If the Hauppauge School District is on a delayed schedule, your child will follow the Hauppauge schedule and will be delayed accordingly.

**Q: Will there be after-school sports, clubs, or SCOPE after school child-care if there is an early release?**

A: **No.** All after-school activities K-12 will be canceled. Students will all be dismissed with no after-care provided by the district.
