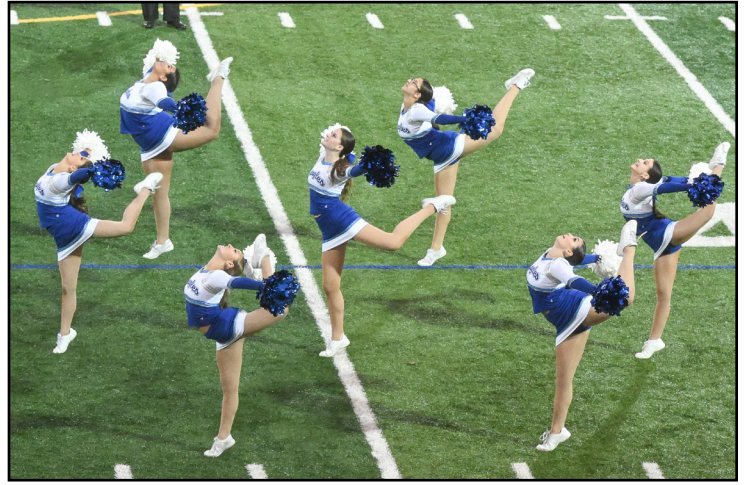

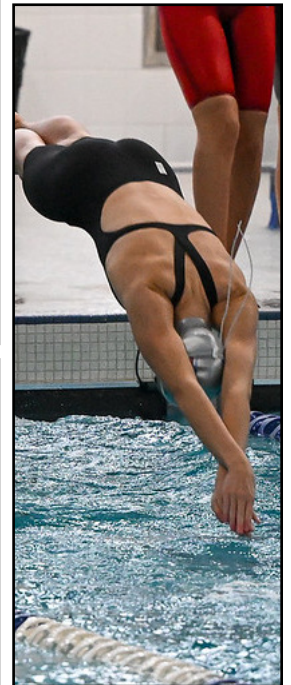


HAUPPAUGE/SMITHTOWN GIRLS SWIMMING TEAM REMAINS UNDEFEATED

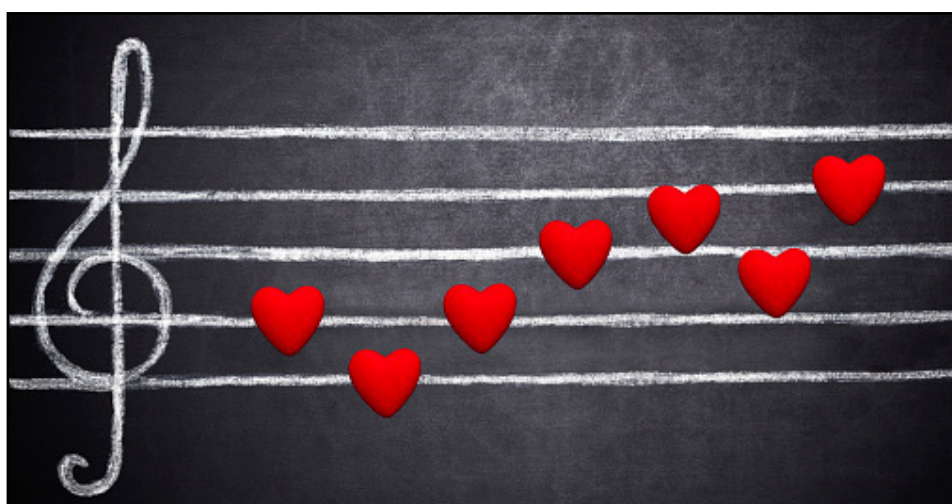
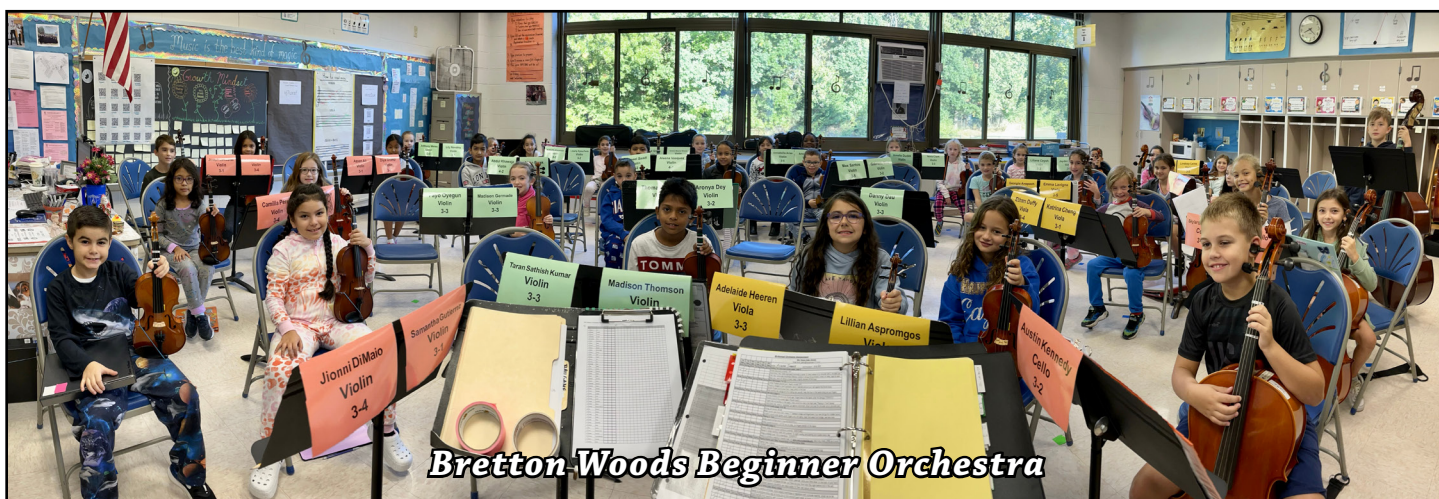

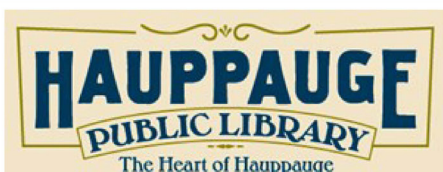
Trunk or Treat
