Congratulations to High School Science teacher, Michael Foley! Mr. Foley is the recipient of the “STEM Star Award” presented by the “Long Island STEM Education Leadership Association.” He received this award on Thursday, May 18th, 2023.

Dr. Wankmuller, Director of Science, Technology, and Research, said the following, “Mr. Foley is a beacon of light that provides equitable access to high quality science education. Mike teaches Earth Science and Biology. He also teaches students in the Effective School Solutions (ESS) program and has ensured that these students completed the lab requirement to be eligible to take the Regents exam. He also is working with students in the ESS program that are enrolled in half-year physics and half-year chemistry using the Edgenuity platform.”

Mr. Foley is a veteran Science teacher with 35 years of experience; and 24 of these are with the Hauppauge Public Schools. He has taught all levels and subjects in Science from AP Biology to Honors Chemistry, to Earth Science and General Science. Mr. Foley received both his Bachelor of Science in Biology and Master of Arts in Liberal Studies from SUNY Stony Brook. In January of 2015, Mr. Foley was selected as a “NYS STEM Master Teacher” for the Long Island Region.



BRETTON WOODS STUDENTS SUPPORT THE “ALS RIDE FOR LIFE”


