

Children need to bring their backpacks in each day with their folder, lunch and homework in it. Please remember to empty your child's folder each night.




### Birthdays

If for some reason your child cannot complete the homework that night, please send in a note acknowledging that the homework was missed and you will make it up the following night.



The children will be allowed to go to the nurse when they do not feel well or get hurt.




A note needs to be sent to school with your child on the day of his/her return with the date and reason for absence.






### Outside Play

Safety is a priority at BW. You will not be permitted into the classroom without signing in, and your child will not be dismissed without you signing him/her out.






### Water Bottles


