


MISSION & PURPOSE

VOLUNTEER

Volunteering in a classroom, or at your place of business, is one of the most rewarding experiences you may ever have. Here is a sample of how you can get involved.

SCHOOL-BASED VOLUNTEERING

JA in a Day: Volunteers teach the JA program in one full day at a nearby elementary or middle school. Volunteers generally "team teach" the full 5-6 sessions with a partner in a one-day workshop format. Alternately, programs can also be delivered by individual volunteers in classrooms one hour a week for 5-8 weeks if they prefer.

COMPANY-BASED VOLUNTEERING

Job Shadow/Youth Conference: Middle or high school students spend 4 hours on-site at a host company learning about the company and industry, while also spending time with volunteer mentors. Mentors share information about their particular job function and professional and academic background. JA New York provides sample agendas and activities. For a more structured experience, companies can also choose to deliver JA curriculum on-site with a group of students.

Bowl-A-Thon: These parties with a purpose are great company outings or team building activities. Lace up and get bowling!

Golf Classic: Enjoy a day of great golf, networking, food and refreshments at our spring and fall golf outings.

Leadership Awards Gala: Held in November in Manhattan, this annual event recognizes individuals who have made significant contributions to JA New York's mission and features our Student of the Year award. JA New York also hosts an annual awards dinner each spring in the Lower Hudson Valley.

Play-4-JA: Choose your favorite activity - spin competition, karaoke night, marathon running, casino night (which JA staff can coordinate) - and use it to raise money for JA New York's K-12 education programs.

A Note to our Partners: JA New York provides its programs to schools with the support of generous corporate, individual and foundation partners.

Each class costs JA New York an average of \$1,000, covering volunteer and school recruitment, training and coordination, classroom materials and administrative expenses.
