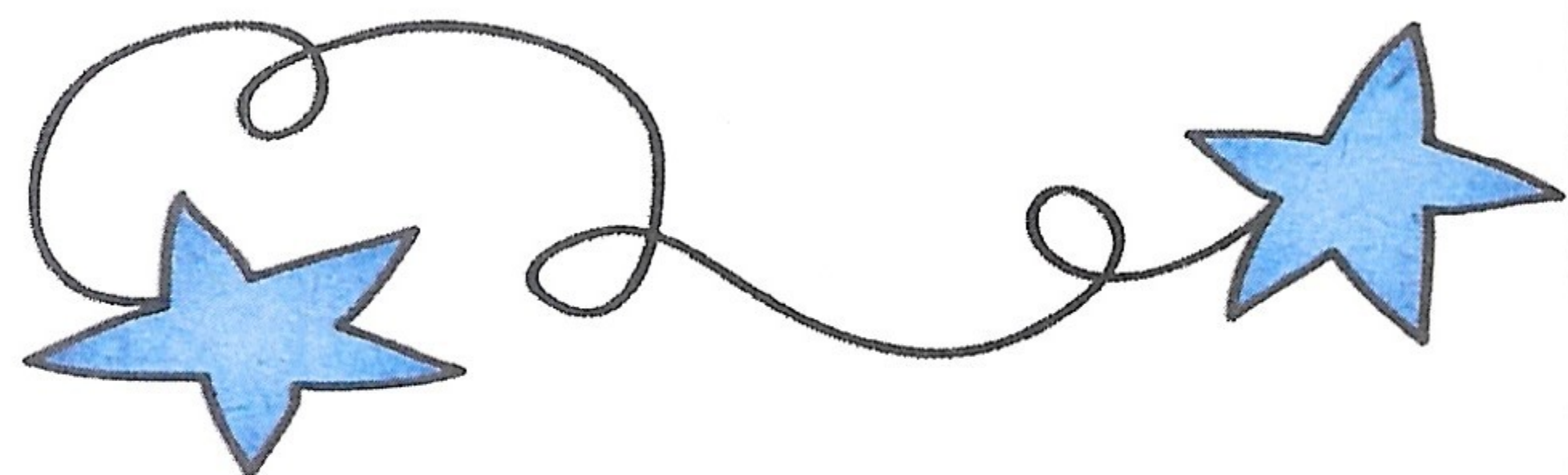


## A Message From the Committee,
