Learners Today, Leaders Tomorrow

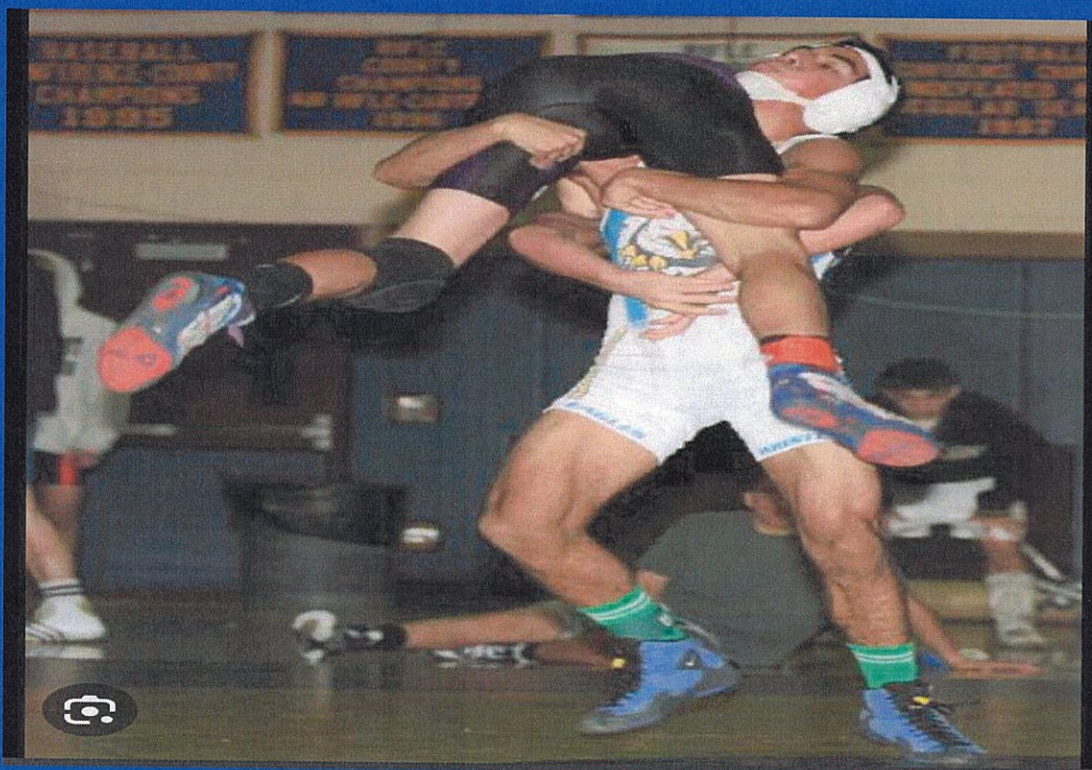
