Dear Hauppauge High School Community,

From January 23 through January 26, 2024, Hauppauge High School will operate on a special testing schedule to administer Midterms and Regents Examinations. These exams are important benchmarks for our students, and they will provide invaluable information for you, the students and our teachers to help students finish off the year successfully and prepare for scheduling the 2024-25 school year.

The information below is applicable to all students, parents and guardians in order to best prepare for success on these exams. Please review everything carefully. Teachers will also review much of this information in their classes leading up to the exam dates.

Testing Schedule

Each day is split into two sessions, AM and PM. Each session has been designed to minimize conflicts as much as possible. Please <u>click here</u> for the schedule and read the chart carefully. Students only need to report to school for their exams, and should leave school grounds upon the conclusion of their exams for the day.

Students should be advised of their testing rooms ahead of time by their teachers. Students must arrive at their testing rooms 15 minutes prior to the exam start times to allow for pre-test directions and administration. Failure to do so may result in a delay of start time or denial of entry to the testing room.

All Regents Exams are three hours in length for standard-time students. Once a Regents Exam has started, students may not leave before, and late students may not begin exams after the "Uniform Admission Deadlines" set by New York State (10:00 for AM exams, and 2:00 for PM exams).

Example: Students taking the **English Regents Exam** on 1/23 will start at 7:45 AM, and they have until 10:45 to complete the exam. They might finish the exam prior to the end time, but they may not leave the exam room until 10:00 at the earliest.

Materials to Bring for Each Exam

Students should come prepared with pens, pencils and water bottles (with labels removed). Please also bring your calculators for Math and Science exams, as directed.

As always, if you have any specific questions about exams, consult with your teachers.

ID Cards

Students must bring their school ID to all exams, as they would for a regular school day.

Cell Phone/ Electronic Device Policy

Cell phones, smart watches and other electronic devices are strictly prohibited in testing rooms. If students bring them to school, they must know their locker locations and combinations to lock away phones and other devices ahead of time. Students may not store phones in offices, and they should not store phones in friends' lockers or unsupervised locations. Individual lockers are the only acceptable spaces to store personal items during exams.

Transportation

We strongly encourage all students to work out their own transportation during the testing dates. Testing start and end times might not perfectly align with our busing schedule. However, we will run our buses according to the schedule below to accommodate anyone who needs to use the bus.

- Regular AM pickup will take place as it normally would for a regular school day.
- We will run a regular departure at 11:00. Since the AM testing window is 7:45-10:45, this gives all students plenty of time to finish their exams within regular time and make it to the bus if needed. Please refer to the "Waiting Time" section below if you need to wait for the bus after your examends.
- We will have "perimeter" departure runs (same as our late buses) at 12:15, 2:20, 4:10 and 5:15 for any student that remains for timing accommodations or sports.
- Exception: On Thursday, 1/25, we will also run a regular departure at our normal end time, 2:20, since we have World Language exams that afternoon.

Once again, during testing sessions, we strongly encourage arranging your own transportation.

Food

Breakfast service will be offered as normal during the testing week. "Grab and Go" lunch and snacks will be available throughout the day as well.

Waiting Time

If students need a place to wait for an upcoming exam or for transportation to arrive, the Auditorium will be open and supervised. The Commons will also be open and supervised for students to eat if they choose to do so. Students may *not* linger in any hallways due to testing, nor may they disrupt any exams.
